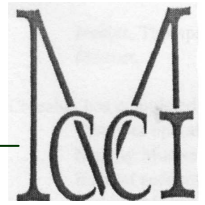

## The ACCC and You

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) is the independent Federal Government body responsible for administering the *Trade Practices Act* (the Act) and other competition related law.

Being familiar with the Act is crucial for all businesses, as it governs many important facets of how you do business – especially in your relationships with consumers and other businesses.

When dealing with other businesses, the Act prohibits anticompetitive conduct, including price fixing, resale price maintenance and misuse of market power. This ensure that businesses compete fairly, based on the merits of their goods and services, and do not resort to illegal tactics to gain business or set prices.

The Act also ensures that businesses act fairly in their dealings with consumers, by preventing businesses from engaging in misleading or deceptive behaviour, or from treating consumers harshly or unfairly. The Act also grants consumers a range of statutory warranties whenever they purchase goods and services.

The ACCC produces a wide range of publications to help explain how the Trade Practices Act affects your business relationships, both with consumers and other businesses. This includes publications produced especially for small businesses which explain technical areas of law clearly and practically

Copies of ACCC publications are available in electronic and hardcopy format, generally free of charge.
